12. What is a *hackamore*?
13. What is the difference in a *cinch* and a *girth*?
14. What are *tapaderos*? May they be used in horse shows?
15. How do you measure the seat of an English type saddle? A western saddle?
16. How do you measure a horse for a blanket?
