





2011 ASIYP COMPETITION




The UPHA Chapter 10 **2011 Fall Horse Show** will host an **ASIYP Competition** with several additional fun classes and special awards sponsored by U.P.H.A. Chapter 10 and the Illinois American Saddlebred Pleasure Horse Association.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION AT SHOW

To be part of the ASIYP Competition, participants must compete in each of the events preceded by a horse icon:

-  *Showmanship In-Hand
-  *ASIYP Horsemanship (Walk/Trot/Canter)
-  *Pattern Class (Walk/Trot/Canter)
-  *Junior Judging

The following events will be available only online and must be completed between September 1 and Oct. 4, 2011. Details will be available at www.asiyp.org after August 15, 2011. More info is available on the back of this page.

-  50 question written test (T/F & multiple choice on general horse knowledge)
-  Hippology (Study general horse knowledge, ASIYP Levels I & II, Saddlebred history, horse terms, etc.)
-  Problem – **Details will be e-mailed when we receive your entry form.**
Demonstration [Optional for individuals/required for teams] - **See description and rules on next page.**

Classes preceded by an asterisk (*) are regular horse show classes. See show list for times and details.

Exhibitors who are enrolled in the ASIYP Competition will receive separate ASIYP 1st thru 6th place ribbons in their age group in each of the above events plus they will earn points toward an ASIYP Top Ten award in their age division (13 & under, 14-17).

Example: If there are 20 exhibitors in Showmanship and fourteen are 13 and under while six are 14-17, and the 14 to 17 year olds placed 1st, 2nd, 4th, 6th, 7th and 9th in the class they would receive 1st thru 6th place ribbons from ASIYP in 14-17 Showmanship class and the younger exhibitors would receive 1st thru 6th place ASIYP ribbons in 13 and under.

TEAM COMPETITION AT SHOW - Exhibitors enrolled in the ASIYP Competition are encouraged to form teams with a **maximum** of four members. Team placings will be determined by totaling each team member's scores in all of the events. Team members will receive special team placing ribbons and the top two scoring teams will receive monetary awards, as well.

ONLINE ONLY COMPETITION - Unable to attend the Chapter 10 Fall Show? You can complete the Written Test, Hippology Test, Problem and Demonstration (as an individual or a team) online and be eligible to receive ribbons and special awards based on your score.

FEES

There is a flat fee to participate in the ASIYP Competition at this show. *This is in addition to the horse show's class entry fees for the Showmanship, Equitation and Pattern classes.*

Individuals not on a team..... \$20.00

Individuals on a team..... \$25.00

SUMMARY OF ASIYP AWARDS EXHIBITORS AT SHOW

CLASS RIBBONS

INDIVIDUALS

- 1st – 6th place ASIYP ribbons in each of the following events in 2 age divisions (13 & under, 14-17):
 1. Junior Judging
 2. Showmanship
 3. Pattern class
 4. Written test
 5. Hippology
 6. Horsemanship
 7. Demonstration
 8. Problem

TEAMS

1st – 6th place ASIYP Team ribbons to each team member on a qualifying team.

TOP TEN

- Top Ten ribbons for 13 & under and 14-17.
- Hi-point in each age group will receive \$100.

Top Ten will be determined by the following formula: In each of the required classes for individuals, all participants will receive a point score. These points will be totaled for each rider in their respective age division to determine **Top Ten**.

TEAMS

- Champion & Reserve **Team Hi-Point** with special ribbons, plus \$50.00 to each member of the Hi-Point team and \$25.00 to each member of the Reserve Hi-Point team.
- Team Hi-Point will be determined by adding each team member's total points.

Tie scores in Top Ten or Teams will be broken using Hippology scores

EXHIBITORS TESTING ONLINE ONLY

1st thru 6th place ribbons in each of the four online tests.

DEMONSTRATION TOPIC

You have been asked to develop and run a booth at an equine promotional event. You are to tell about parasites, and their control, in horses. Research the topic and prepare some graphics to show during your presentation. Considerable information is available online. You need to limit your demonstration to not more than 5 minutes. Prepare your booth, presentation and accompanying materials at a location of your choice and **VIDEO YOUR PRESENTATION**. If you are on a team, include all team members in the presentation.
